19-208. LIMITATIONS ON SECRETARY.

(A) PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS.

THE POWER OF THE SECRETARY OVER PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS OF UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE POWER TO DISAPPROVE OR MODIFY ANY DECISION OR DETERMINATION THAT THE COMMISSION MAKES UNDER AUTHORITY SPECIFICALLY DELEGATED BY LAW TO THE COMMISSION.

(B) STAFF, FUNCTIONS, AND FUNDS.

THE POWER OF THE SECRETARY TO TRANSFER BY RULE, REGULATION, OR WRITTEN DIRECTIVE, ANY STAFF, FUNCTIONS, OR FUNDS OF UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY STAFF, FUNCTION, OR FUNDS OF THE COMMISSION.

This section is rephrased to exclude the Commission from the general powers of the Secretary under § 2-104(f) and (h) of this article. 19-209. JURISDICTION OF COMMISSION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT FOR A FACILITY THAT IS OPERATED OR IS LISTED AND CERTIFIED BY THE FIRST CHURCH OF CHRIST, SCIENTIST, BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS, THE COMMISSION HAS JURISDICTION OVER ALL FACILITIES.

The defined term "facility" is substituted for the reference to "hospitals and related institutions, whether ... profit making or nonprofit making institutions", for brevity.
