

(2) AS A NURSING HOME IF THE RELATED INSTITUTION:

(I) PROVIDES NURSING CARE FOR CHRONICALLY ILL OR CONVALESCENT PATIENTS; OR

(II) OFFERS TO PROVIDE 24-HOUR A DAY NURSING CARE OF PATIENTS IN A HOME-TYPE FACILITY SUCH AS:

1. A CONVALESCENT HOME;
2. A NURSING UNIT OF A HOME FOR THE AGED;
3. A PSYCHIATRIC NURSING HOME;
4. A NURSING FACILITY FOR THE HANDICAPPED;
5. A HOME FOR ALCOHOLICS; OR
6. A HALFWAY HOUSE.

#### 19-308. STANDARDS AND INSPECTIONS.

##### (A) STANDARDS.

(1) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS OF SERVICES FOR THE CARE AND MEDICAL SUPERVISION OF RESIDENTS IN RELATED INSTITUTIONS.

(2) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS FOR SAFETY AND SANITATION IN THE PHYSICAL PLANT AND IN THE DIAGNOSTIC, THERAPEUTIC, AND LABORATORY FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT OF HOSPITALS AND RELATED INSTITUTIONS.
