19-351. STAFF.

(A) LIMITATION ON SUBTITLE.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT AFFECT THE RIGHT OF A HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION TO EMPLOY STAFF.

(B) PODIATRISTS.

(1) A HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION THAT PROVIDES MEDICAL OR SURGICAL CARE OF THE FOOT, OTHER THAN INCIDENTAL CARE, SHALL INCLUDE, IN ITS BYLAWS, RULES, OR REGULATIONS, PROVISIONS FOR USE OF FACILITIES BY AND STAFF PRIVILEGES FOR QUALIFIED PODIATRISTS.

(2) THE HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION MAY RESTRICT USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF PRIVILEGES BY PODIATRISTS TO THOSE PODIATRISTS WHO MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS THAT THE HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION SETS FOR GRANTING THOSE PRIVILEGES.

19-354. TORT LIABILITY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION IS NOT IMMUNE FROM LIABILITY FOR NEGLIGENCE OR ANY OTHER TORT ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE HOSPITAL OR RELATED INSTITUTION IS A CHARITABLE INSTITUTION.
