(4) TO BRIDGE THE GAP IN COMMUNITY HEALTH SERVICES FOR PATIENTS WHO OTHERWISE COULD NOT GET ADEQUATE HEALTH CARE.

In item (1) of this section, the former phrase "if possible" is deleted as unnecessary.

19-403. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT:

(1) LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY PERSON TO PRACTICE A HEALTH OCCUPATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE;

(2) LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO ACT AS AUTHORIZED BY THAT LICENSE; OR

(3) PROHIBIT THE CARE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RELIES ON TREATMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TENETS AND PRACTICES OF A RECOGNIZED CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS DENOMINATION AND, WITH OR WITHOUT COMPENSATION, IS CARED FOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THOSE TENETS AND PRACTICES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Items (1) and (2) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 878(d)(4) and rephrased to state explicitly that this subtitle applies to an agency and not to an individual practitioner who makes a house call in the course of a private practice.

Item (3) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from the third sentence of former Article 43, § 882 and revised to conform to similar provisions elsewhere in this article.
