an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

The President put the question: Shall the Bill pass, notwithstanding the objections of the Executive

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 990.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State Debt to be used as a State grant to assist in the design and construction of an enlargement of the Montgomery County Detention Center.

House Bill 583, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 990.
