State-Owned Motor Vehicles - Reassignment

FOR the purpose of providing that the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning may reassign, on an interdepartmental basis, state-owned motor vehicles under certain conditions; and authorizing alternate criteria for assigning motor vehicles under certain circumstances.
