AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Budget and Finance

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Carroll County Commissioners to establish a fund for self insurance of county property; providing that the Commissioners may set certain limits on the fund; providing that the annual county appropriations shall make certain reimbursements to the fund; enumerating what moneys are included in the Carroll County surplus fund; ~~authorizing--a--reserve--fund--for---permanent---public improvements--to--be--funded--from--a--specific--source; delineating--certain--procedures--for--public--hearings before--any--expenditure--is--made--from--the--reserve--fund for--permanent--public--improvements; providing that the reserve fund be used for a certain purpose; and generally relating to budgeting and financial considerations in Carroll County.~~
