## House Bill No. 903

AN ACT concerning

Adoption - Consent of Minor Parent

FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law relating to the effect of a natural parent's minority on the parent's ability to consent to adoption or guardianship.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 16 - Chancery Section 74 Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement) (As enacted by Chapter 221 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1970)

Senate Bill 338, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 933.
