AN ACT concerning

Public Education - State Aid

FOR the purpose of ~~altering--the--fiscal--year--used--to calculate the State share of basic current expenses--to public--education, providing that certain State aid may not be less than aid received during a--certain--fiscal year~~ providing that in addition to the State share of basic current expenses, certain counties shall receive hold harmless aid in fiscal year 1983; and generally relating to State financial aid to public education.
