House Bill No. 1343

AN ACT concerning

Memorial Stadium Seating and Field Facilities Loan of 1980

FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 529 of the Acts of 1980, to provide for and alter the periods in which certain deductions and transfers shall be made by the Comptroller, and to provide a method to calculate the amount of those deductions and transfers in certain circumstances.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 529 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1980
Section 1(5)
