Vetoed Bills from 1982 --

- H.B. 56-Rail Property Acquisition Loan of 1981 - Includes the rail facilities of Westminster to Cedarhurst in the bond authorization.....9 (2076)
- H.B. 155-Emergency vehicle liability - Provides that certain operators of certain emergency vehicles are not liable for certain acts or omissions under certain circumstances and generally relates thereto.....10 (2077)
- H.B. 165-Baltimore City - Alters the annual expense allowance of the Sheriff, assistant and undersheriffs, and deputy sheriffs.....13 (2078)
- H.B. 321-Hood College Loan of 1982 - Creates a State Debt with proceeds for construction of the Resource Management Facility located at Hood College.....15 (2079)
- H.B. 344-Mobile home parks - Provides that certain violations are within the scope of the enforcement duties of the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General and relates thereto..16 (2080)
- H.B. 479-Pensions - Allows certain members of the Employees' Retirement and Pension Systems to participate in the Optional Retirement Program.....18 (2081)
- H.B. 480-Pensions - Permits a person who has elected to receive a vested retirement allowance from a State system to designate a beneficiary to receive a person's accumulated contributions in the event the person dies prior to the effective date of retirement.....19 (2082)
- H.B. 482-Pensions - Provides that certain former members of the State retirement systems may receive service retirement allowances as of a certain date following receipt of written applications.....20 (2083)
- H.B. 491-Pensions - Repeals the provisions that define "service" for purposes of eligibility in the Employees' and Teachers' Pension Systems.....21 (2084)
- H.B. 494-Pensions - Includes previous service time with the State or with a public school as a teacher for credit towards eligibility for benefits in the State Employees' and Teachers' Pension Systems.....22 (2085)
- H.B. 495-Pensions - Corrects certain errors and repeals certain obsolete phrases in the Pension Article.....24 (2086)
- H.B. 508-State Use Industries - Provides that the Legislative Auditor shall conduct audits of the State Use Industries and generally relates thereto.....25 (2087)
- H.B. 541-Emergency evaluations - Provides that certain petitioners for emergency evaluations shall present a petition to the court and relates thereto.....26 (2088)
