In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 463.

This bill allows Prince George's County to use the "Prince George's County Detention Center Loan of 1975" for the purpose of construction of and equipping the proposed Prince George's County Detention Complex.

House Bill 627, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 463.
