- [(m)] (N) "Revenues" means, but is not limited to, all revenues and moneys received by the Administration from or in connection with any energy project, including proceeds of loans or bonds, grants, insurance, investments, rentals, rates, fees, and charges for the use of the services furnished or made available, and any other income inuring to the Administration, as the term "revenues" may be applied to a particular project, financing, or other matter.
- [(n)] (0) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Economic and Community Development.
- (P) (1) "SOLAR ENERGY PROJECT" MEANS, WITH RESPECT TO ANY COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL BUILDING, ANY ADDITION, ALTERATION, OR IMPROVEMENT THAT IS DESIGNED TO UTILIZE WIND ENERGY, ENERGY PRODUCED BY A WOOD BURNING APPLIANCE, OR SOLAR ENERGY, EITHER OF THE ACTIVE TYPE BASED ON MECHANICALLY FORCED ENERGY TRANSFER OR OF THE PASSIVE TYPE BASED ON CONVECTIVE, CONDUCTIVE, OR RADIANT ENERGY TRANSFER (OR SOME COMBINATION OF THESE TYPES), TO REDUCE THE ENERGY REQUIREMENTS OF THE BUILDING.
- (2) "SOLAR ENERGY PROJECT" INCLUDES A SOLAR PROCESS HEAT DEVICE, SOLAR ELECTRIC DEVICE, OR ANY EARTH SHELTERED BUILDING IN WHICH THE SHELTERING SUBSTANTIALLY REDUCES THE CONSUMPTION OF ENERGY BY THE BUILDING.

- (e) (1) It is a condition precedent for the provision of financial assistance for an energy project that is delineated in subsections [(e)](H)(4)(i), [(e)](H)(6), or [(e)](H)(8) of § 518 of this subtitle that the political subdivision in which the energy project will be located shall adopt a resolution that shall:
- (i) Specify and describe the energy project;and
- $\mbox{\ \ (ii)\ \ Generally\ \ describe\ \ the\ public\ purpose\ to\ be\ served\ by\ the\ energy\ project.}$
- (2) A resolution adopted under this section is administrative in nature, is not subject to procedures required for legislative acts, and is not subject to referendum.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General
