

(iii) The State appropriation for any of these purposes.]

(2) BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT, THE UNIVERSITY MAY SPEND, OR ENCUMBER, WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THEY ARE RECEIVED, REVENUES RECEIVED IN EXCESS OF THOSE ESTIMATED FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR.

(3) THE UNEXPENDED OR UNENCUMBERED BALANCES OF THE UNIVERSITY'S GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION, INCLUDING THE AMOUNTS RECEIVED AS REIMBURSEMENT OF STATEWIDE INDIRECT COSTS, SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL TREASURY OF THE STATE AT THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR. ALL OTHER UNEXPENDED OR UNENCUMBERED BALANCES OF THE UNIVERSITY'S REVENUES:

~~(i) -- ARE EXEMPT FROM ARTICLE 15A, -- § -- 2 -- OF -- THE CODE;~~ (i) SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE COMPTROLLER, AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH THE APPROPRIATION WAS MADE;

(II) DO NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL TREASURY OF THE STATE AT THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR; AND

(III) SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE UNIVERSITY FOR EXPENDITURE THROUGH AN APPROPRIATION CONTAINED IN A BUDGET BILL OR THROUGH AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.

(4) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE INTERPRETED IN ANY WAY THAT WOULD DIMINISH THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS UNDER § 13-104(B) OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 305

(Senate Bill 72)

AN ACT concerning

Small Businesses - Litigation Expenses

FOR the purpose of permitting the award of certain expenses to small businesses in certain civil and administrative cases between small businesses and certain State agencies; providing for the source of funds for these awards; providing for the reduction or denial of awards under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the award of certain expenses to small
