AN ACT concerning

Notaries Public - Out-of-State Court Reporters

FOR the purpose of allowing out-of-state court reporters to obtain a notary commission for certain limited purposes; specifying the rules and regulations pertaining to the application process; establishing a term of office; prescribing fees; and generally relating to out-of-state court reporters commissioned as notaries public in the State of Maryland.
