

(4) There is hereby levied and imposed an annual State tax on all assessable property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and when due and until paid in full, such principal to be discharged within fifteen years of the date of issue of the bonds.

(5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the John F. Kennedy Institute for Handicapped Children shall provide at least an equal and matching fund of \$1,300,000. No part of an applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. The John F. Kennedy Institute for Handicapped Children has until June 1, 1985, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1985, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1983.

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt -
Robert Long House

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Historic Fund, Inc., for the purpose of restoration, improvement, furnishing, construction, and landscaping of the structure, outbuildings, facilities, and property known as the Robert Long House at 810-812 South Ann Street in Baltimore City; subject to the requirement that the Historic Fund, Inc. provide at least a matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; providing that
