CHAPTER 324

(Senate Bill 307)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Housing Authority Bonds

FOR the purpose of providing that bonds of the Washington County Housing Authority may be sold at public or private sales in the manner and on the terms authorized by resolution of the Authority.
