

FOR the purpose of allowing the name of a corporation to include certain abbreviations to indicate corporate status; and making clarifying and stylistic changes.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Corporations and Associations
Section 2-106(a)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1975 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Corporations and Associations

2-106.

(a) The name of the corporation shall indicate its corporate status. Corporate status is indicated if the name contains one of the following words or [ends with] an abbreviation of one of them:

- (1) [Company] "COMPANY", if it is not preceded by the word "and" or a symbol for [it] "AND";
- (2) "Corporation";
- (3) "Incorporated"; or
- (4) "Limited[.]".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
