(b) (1) The Board consists of [seven] 8 members appointed by the Governor who shall represent the various geographical areas of the State. No more than one member of the Board shall be a resident of the same county or of Baltimore City.

(2) Of the [seven] 8 members:

(i) Two shall be members of the scientific community in the State, one of whom shall be a geologist;

(ii) [Two] THREE shall be members of the general public who have no financial interest in the waste disposal industry, at least one of whom has had a demonstrated involvement in environmental matters;

(iii) One shall be appointed from a list of three or more persons nominated by the Maryland Association of Counties;

(iv) One shall be appointed from a list of three or more persons nominated by the Maryland Chamber of Commerce; and

(v) One shall be appointed from a list of three or more persons nominated by the Maryland Municipal League.
