

(10) Commits any act of unprofessional conduct, as defined by the rules and regulations of the Board, or violates the code of ethics adopted by the Board;

(11) Violates any lawful order given or rule or regulation adopted by the Board; [or]

(12) Violates any provision of this title[.];

(13) PROVIDES PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WHILE:

(I) UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL; OR

(II) USING ANY NARCOTIC OR CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27 OF THE CODE, OR OTHER DRUG THAT IS IN EXCESS OF THERAPEUTIC AMOUNTS OR WITHOUT VALID MEDICAL INDICATION;

(14) IS DISCIPLINED BY A LICENSING OR DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY OF ANY OTHER STATE OR COUNTRY OR CONVICTED OR DISCIPLINED BY A COURT OF ANY STATE OR COUNTRY FOR AN ACT THAT WOULD BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THE BOARD'S DISCIPLINARY STATUTES;

(15) PRACTICES SPEECH PATHOLOGY WITH AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON OR SUPERVISES OR AIDS AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON IN THE PRACTICE OF SPEECH PATHOLOGY;

(16) WILLEFULLY MAKES OR FILES A FALSE REPORT OR RECORD IN THE PRACTICE OF SPEECH PATHOLOGY;

(17) WILLEFULLY FAILS TO FILE OR RECORD ANY REPORT AS REQUIRED BY LAW, WILLEFULLY IMPEDES OR OBSTRUCTS THE FILING OR RECORDING OF THE REPORT, OR INDUCES ANOTHER TO FAIL TO FILE OR RECORD THE REPORT; OR

(18) SUBMITS A FALSE REPORT TO COLLECT A FEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
