CHAPTER 394

(House Bill 812)

AN ACT concerning

State Lottery - ~~Instant-Lottery-Games~~ Lotto Games

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Commission and Director to provide for a certain number of instant lottery ~~games to be held during a certain fiscal year~~ "Lotto" game on a weekly basis; providing for the issuance of regulations; providing for distributions of certain proceeds to political subdivisions on a certain basis providing that "Lotto" game receipts shall be placed in a special account; providing for the distributions of "Lotto" receipts under certain circumstances; providing that certain provisions of this Act shall terminate and be of no further force and effect after a certain date; authorizing political subdivisions to accrue certain funds as revenues for the 1984 fiscal year; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the provision and conduct of games of chance known as "Lotto" games by the State Lottery Commission and Director.
