THE EXPRESS POWERS CONTAINED AND--ENUMERATED--IN THE OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLES 25, 25A, AND 25B OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND ARE INTENDED TO BE AND SHALL BE DEEMED AMENDED AND MODIFIED AS PROVIDED IN § 2A.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1984.

CHAPTER 399

(House Bill 3)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Learner's Permit Expiration

FOR the purpose of altering the length of time after which a learner's permit expires; and altering the fee for such permits.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation
Section 16-105(e) and 16-111.1(a)(1)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1977 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-105.

(e) A learner's permit expires [3 months] 180 DAYS after date of issuance.

16-111.1.

(a) (1) When an applicant applies for an [original] INITIAL driver's license or for a class of driver's license other than that which [he] THE APPLICANT currently holds, the applicant shall pay the Administration a license fee of [\$20] \$22. This fee covers issuance of a learner's permit and, if the applicant qualifies before the learner's permit expires, issuance of a driver's license.
