FOR the purpose of providing that the term of office for a County Commissioner of Washington County begins on the first Tuesday in December after the November election.

THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR A COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF WASHINGTON COUNTY BEGINS ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN DECEMBER AFTER THE NOVEMBER ELECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

- FOR the purpose of providing that a student who has been suspended or expelled from a public institution of elementary, secondary, or higher education may be denied access to the building or grounds of the institution under certain circumstances.
