## CHAPTER 446

(House Bill 779)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County - Ethics MC 248-83

FOR the purpose of providing that certain officials in Montgomery County are to be treated as local officials for the purpose of certain conflict of interest, financial disclosure, and lobbying disclosure requirements enacted by the Montgomery County Council; and making stylistic changes.

BY adding to

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law Section 6-102 and 6-303 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law Section 6-202 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law
