- (O) ANY ACTION OR DETERMINATION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REQUIRED OR PERMITTED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE TAKEN OR MADE SOLELY BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD.
- (P) NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SECTION SHALL EXEMPT THE COMMISSION FROM COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 19-101 ET SEQ. OF THE HEALTH-GENERAL ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF OR EXPENDITURES BY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 476

(House Bill 1130)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - McComas Institute and Hosanna School

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$25,000 \$50,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Historic District Commission of Harford County for the purpose of restoration, renovation, and reconstruction of the McComas Institute located in Emmorton, Maryland and for the restoration, renovation, reconstruction, and stabilization of the Freeman's School known as the Hosanna School on Castleton Road in Darlington, Maryland; prohibiting the use of certain funds for certain religious purposes; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the McComas Institute and Hosanna School Loan of 1983 in the aggregate principal amount of \$25,000 \$50,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
