[(d)] (E) Except as provided in this subsection, AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED FOR SHELTERED WORKSHOPS, all suitable supplies and services, hereafter procured by or for the State or any of its agencies, shall be procured, in accordance with applicable specifications of the Department of General Services, from charitable nonprofit agencies for the handicapped, organized under the laws of this State and manufacturing the supplies and offering services within this State, with the approval of the Department of General Services whenever the supplies and services are available at a price determined to be the fair market price for the product, supplies or services manufactured or offered.]
