

(4) TO A PERSON WHO IS THE ALLEGED CHILD ABUSER OR THE PERSON WHO IS SUSPECTED OF CHILD NEGLECT IF THAT PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S WELFARE AND PROVISIONS ARE MADE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE IDENTITY OF THE REPORTER OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHOSE LIFE OR SAFETY IS LIKELY TO BE ENDANGERED BY DISCLOSING THE INFORMATION.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

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CHAPTER 493

(House Bill 1419)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt -  
Queen Anne's County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Commissioners of Queen Anne's County for the purpose of planning the Queen Anne's County Jail; subject to the requirement that the Board of Commissioners of Queen Anne's County provide at least an equal and matching amount for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Queen Anne's County Jail Loan of 1983 in the aggregate principal amount of \$100,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement, as amended from time to time).

(2) The bonds issued to evidence this loan or installments thereof may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 2B of Article 31 of the Code.
