- (1) Upon two stores or more but not to exceed five stores, the annual license fee shall be -{-five dollars-}- \$20 for each such store;
- (2) Upon each store in excess of five, but not to exceed ten, the annual license fee shall be -{-twenty dollars-}-\$80 for each such additional store;
- (3) Upon each store in excess of ten, but not to exceed twenty, the annual license fee shall be $-\frac{1}{2}$ -one hundred dollars- $\frac{1}{2}$ -\$400 for each such additional store;
- (4) Upon each store in excess of twenty, the annual license fee shall be - \dagger -one hundred and fifty dollars- \dagger \$600 for each such additional store. The term "store" or mercantile establishments as used herein shall not be construed to include automobile service stations at which the principal business is the sale or distribution of gasoline and motor fuel.
- (B) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 - (1) ON 2 TO 5 STORES, \$10 FOR EACH STORE;
 - (2) ON 6 TO 10 STORES, \$40 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL STORE;
