- (A) BEFORE ISSUING A TRADER'S LICENSE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE CLERK SHALL COLLECT A FEE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE AMOUNT OF THE APPLICANT'S STOCK IN TRADE.
- (B) (1) IF THE AMOUNT OF THE APPLICANT'S STOCK IN TRADE DOES NOT OR WILL NOT EXCEED \$1,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$15.
- (2) IF MORE THAN \$1,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$5,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$59 \$30.
- (3) IF MORE THAN \$5,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$10,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$100 \$60.
- (4) IF MORE THAN \$10,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$50,000, THE FEE SHALL BE $\$25\theta$ \$120.
- (5) IF MORE THAN \$50,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$100,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$750 \$300.
- (6) IF MORE THAN \$100,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$300,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$1,500 \$750.
- (7) IF MORE THAN \$300,000 AND NOT MORE THAN \$750,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$2,500 \$1,200.
- (8) IF MORE THAN \$750,000, THE FEE SHALL BE \$3,500 \$1,700.
