

{ (4) } - { (3) } -- For any other vehicle, the width limit is { 96 } - 102 inches.

{ (a) } -- For purposes of this section, the length of a vehicle includes its front and rear bumpers and any part of its load that extends beyond the vehicle.

{ (b) } - { (1) } -- This section does not apply to any vehicle or combination of vehicles carrying:

{ (i) } -- Piling, poles, or mill logs, or

{ (ii) } -- Crew or racing shells.

{ (2) } -- This section does not prohibit the use of a combination of vehicles to carry an indivisible load that is not over 70 feet long.

{ (c) } -- Except as otherwise provided in this section:

{ (1) } -- A single unit truck may not be over 40 feet long,

{ (2) } -- A publicly owned rigid bus may not be over 41 feet long,

{ (3) } -- A publicly owned articulated three axle bus may not be over 56 feet long, { and }

{ (4) } -- { Any other vehicle or combination of vehicles may not be over 55 feet long. } -- WHEN A SEMITRAILER { SINGLE } OR A SEMITRAILER AND TRAILER { DOUBLE } IS BEING OPERATED IN COMBINATION WITH A TRUCK TRACTOR, THE COMBINATION OF VEHICLES IS NOT SUBJECT TO AN OVERALL LENGTH LIMITATION,

{ (5) } -- WHEN A SEMITRAILER { SINGLE } IS IN COMBINATION WITH A TRUCK TRACTOR, THE SEMITRAILER MAY NOT BE OVER 48 FEET LONG.

{ (D) } - { (1) } -- WHEN A SEMITRAILER AND TRAILER { DOUBLE } IS IN COMBINATION WITH A TRUCK TRACTOR, EACH UNIT OF THE SEMITRAILER OR TRAILER MAY NOT BE OVER 28 FEET LONG.

{ (2) } -- EXCEPT WHEN IT IS BEING OPERATED ON A HIGHWAY THAT IS THE SHORTEST PRACTICAL ROUTE BETWEEN AN INTERSTATE OR PRIMARY HIGHWAY AND A TRUCK TERMINAL OF ORIGIN OR DESTINATION, A SEMITRAILER AND TRAILER { DOUBLE } IN COMBINATION WITH A TRUCK TRACTOR SHALL BE OPERATED ONLY ON INTERSTATE AND PRIMARY HIGHWAYS. --

{ (d) } -- If it is hauling, or is traveling empty or with poultry cages to or from hauling, live poultry anywhere within the counties of Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's,
