- (2) The route to be followed; and
- (3) The date and hour on which the trip is to be made.

## 24-113.

- (a) The purpose of this section is to:
  - (1) Facilitate the obtaining of permits;
- (2) Eliminate undue hardships to political subdivisions, contractors, and the movers of heavy or large equipment; and
- (3) Make possible, when circumstances justify, the issuing of permits under which more than one move can be made.
- (b) The State Highway Administration and the Maryland State Police jointly may formulate rules and regulations that:
- (1) Implement the statutes on the movement of oversize and overweight vehicles; and
  - (2) Establish fees and charges under these statutes.
- (c) (1) Before a rule or regulation may be adopted or amended under this section, the proposed rule, regulation, or amendment shall be published once a week for 2 successive weeks in at least two newspapers of general circulation in this State. The publication shall set forth the proposal and specify a time and place for a public hearing on it.
- (2) After the hearing, the State Highway Administration may adopt the proposed rule, regulation, or amendment or any appropriate modification to it.
- (d) [Rules and regulations adopted under this section may not modify the height, width, length, or weight restrictions set by law] IN EXCEPTIONAL CASES, SPECIAL VEHICLE PERMITS MAY BE ISSUED FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING MAXIMUM SIZE AND WEIGHT LIMITATIONS; HOWEVER, IT IS NOT INTENDED TO ALLOW REGULAR AND CONTINUOUS MOVEMENT BY A VEHICLE OPERATING WITH A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
