- (4) The [registered] CERTIFIED mail notice required by § 25-204 of this title is returned as undeliverable.
 - (c) The notice by publication:
- (1) May contain multiple listings of abandoned vehicles;
- (2) Shall contain the information required by § 25-204 of this title; and
 - (3) Shall be published:
- (i) Within 15 days of the taking into custody of the vehicle; or $% \left\{ 1,2,\ldots ,2\right\}$
- (ii) If the notice by publication is made because of the return as undeliverable of a prior notice by [registered mail] CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, BEARING A POSTMARK FROM THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE, within 7 days of the return of that prior notice.

- (f) Notice of revocation sent by [registered mail] CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, BEARING A POSTMARK FROM THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE, to the motor carrier at its last known address is sufficient notice that its registration and operating privileges are revoked under this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
