waters; providing for the issuance of this license by the Department of Natural Resources; requiring a power dredging license for certain people who catch oysters under this Act; defining a certain term; providing a certain fee for this license; providing for the return and exchange of certain oyster licenses; providing a time for taking oysters under this Act; providing for a certain oyster catching season under this Act; providing certain catch limits; providing for certain sizes of power dredges; allowing the Secretary of Natural Resources to adopt certain rules and regulations to---change---the--provisions--of--this--Act--under--certain eenditiens; providing certain penalties for violations of this Act; generally relating to the catching of oysters with a power dredge in Somerset County; and making-this-Ast-an emergency--measure; and providing that this Act shall terminate on a certain date.
