Article 11 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 11 - Frederick County

2-8-5.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY MAY BORROW AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000,000 IN ANY FISCAL YEAR FROM A BANK OR OTHER LENDING INSTITUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING LOANS TO VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENTS IN FREDERICK COUNTY TO PURCHASE VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT TO BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENTS. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPROVE ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON LOANS FROM A BANK OR OTHER LENDING INSTITUTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 40

(House Bill 597)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Erection and Maintenance of Traffic
Signals - Local Authority

FOR the purpose of deleting a reference to the Frederick County Roads Board from the authority of the Board of County Commissioners to erect and maintain traffic control devices; and providing that fines collected for failure to obey stop signs, defacing, removing, or damaging a traffic control device shall be paid to the Board of County Commissioners for road maintenance.
