CHAPTER 591

(Senate Bill 216)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - The City Temple of Baltimore

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to The City Temple of Baltimore for the purpose of restoration and renovation of the exterior of The City Temple of Baltimore; subject to the requirement that The City Temple of Baltimore provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; providing that certain easements be granted to the Maryland Historical Trust; providing that no proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for religious purposes; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as The City Temple of Baltimore Loan of 1983 in
