

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial consumer members of this Board shall be appointed by July 1, 1984, and that one shall serve a term of 1 year, to end June 30, 1985, and the other a term of 2 years, to end June 30, 1986. Either of the initial consumer members may be reappointed for full terms.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 596

(House Bill 119)

AN ACT concerning

Division of Labor and Industry -
Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner

FOR the purpose of permitting the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to appoint the Deputy Commissioner with the approval of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation; clarifying that the office of Commissioner is a full-time office; allowing the deputy holding office on the effective date of this Act to continue in the position subject to Article 64A; repealing certain provisions relating to the selection and salary of the deputy; repealing certain obsolete provisions; and generally relating to the Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner of the Division of Labor and Industry.
