

There is an Advisory Board on Liability to study the implications of the liability of individuals engaged in activities of State and local governmental and quasi-governmental volunteer units.]

(a) The Board includes:

(1) A designee of the Maryland Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation;

(2) Two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker;

(3) Two members of the Senate, to be appointed by the President;

(4) A designee of the Maryland Association of Counties;

(5) A designee of the Maryland Municipal League;

(6) A designee from the Maryland Technical Advisory Service at the University of Maryland;

(7) A designee from the Governor's office;

(8) A designee of the Maryland State Bar Association;

(9) a representative of the Insurance Commissioner's Office; and

(10) Two members appointed by the Governor who represent special taxing districts, one of whom shall represent a civic association acting as the governing body of a special taxing district.

(b) The Governor shall designate one of the members of the Board to be the chairman of the Board.]

Members of the Board may not receive compensation for their services but may be reimbursed for proper and necessary expenses incurred in accordance with the standard travel regulations.]

[514.

The Board shall:

(1) Review lawsuits involving State and local officials and civic organizations acting as governing bodies of special taxing districts or their members;
