Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments
Section 4A

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

4A.

[It is unlawful for any] ANY person [to operate] WHO OPERATES an aircraft towing an advertisement for promotional purposes at an altitude BELOW THE MINIMUM SAFE ALTITUDE SPECIFIED BY APPLICABLE FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS [of less than ~~-[3,000-]-~~ 1,000 feet] over any public or private sporting arena in Baltimore City [including the airspace above a ~~-[one-mile-]~~ 2,000 FOOT radius from the arena-~~-~~. Violation of this section] is GUILTY OF a misdemeanor [punishable by] AND ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO a fine of not more than ~~-\$500-~~ \$1500[.00].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
