

CHAPTER 52

(House Bill 771)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Country
 Inn Zone
 MC 213-83

FOR the purpose of providing that a prohibition on on-sale alcoholic beverages licenses does not include certain restaurants located within the Country Inn Zone of Montgomery County; providing a certain limitation on the number of licenses issued; defining a certain term; and clarifying language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

37.

(A) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION "PLACE OF BUSINESS" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

(I) A COUNTRY CLUB; OR

(II) A RESTAURANT LOCATED WITHIN THE COUNTRY INN ZONE OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ONLY; PROVIDED THAT A MAXIMUM OF 2 (TWO) SUCH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES MAY BE ISSUED IN ANY ELECTION DISTRICT IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

[(a)] (2) In Montgomery County, [no] A license for the sale of alcoholic beverages authorized by this article [shall] MAY NOT be issued for any place of business located in any one of the
