Article 62 - Marriages

- (a) The clerk of the court shall receive \$10 for every license issued and for the performance of the other duties required by this article. Of this \$10, \$5 shall be retained by the clerk, and \$5 shall be paid to the county treasurer for use as general funds.
- (B) (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, ANY COUNTY OR ANY GROUP OF 2 OR MORE COUNTIES MAY SET AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF UP TO \$15 FOR EACH LICENSE.
- (2) THE PROCEEDS FROM THE ADDITIONAL FEE SHALL BE USED TO FUND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS.
- (c) (1) In Baltimore City, in addition to all other fees imposed under this article, the clerks may be directed by ordinance of the Mayor and City Council to receive [an additional \$5] UP TO \$15 for every license issued.
- (2) The clerk shall remit monthly the proceeds of the additional fee to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City.
- (3) The proceeds shall be used to fund domestic violence programs which have 24 hour intake ability.
- (d) (1) In Montgomery County, in addition to all other fees imposed under this article, the clerk of the court may be directed by resolution of the county council to receive [\$5] UP TO \$15 for every license issued.
- $\,$ (2) The clerk shall remit the proceeds of this additional fee monthly to the director of finance of Montgomery County.
- (3) The proceeds shall be used in addition to designated federal, State, and county funds in funding battered spouse shelters and domestic violence programs.
- (4) The county executive shall prepare an annual report on the disposition of fees collected under this article. The report shall be available no later than December 1 subsequent to the fiscal year being reported.
- (e) (1) In Baltimore County, in addition to all other fees imposed under this article, the clerk of the court may be directed by resolution of the county council to receive [\$10] UP TO \$15 for every license issued.
- (2) The clerk shall remit the proceeds of this additional fee monthly to the director of finance of Baltimore County.
