(A) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADMINISTER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) A STATE OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE, STATE UNIVERSITY, AN AGENCY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR ANY OTHER PERSON APPROVED AND DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT MAY ORGANIZE A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TRAINING CENTER AND MAY OFFER MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSES AT THOSE CENTERS THAT IT OPERATES.

(C) (1) SUBJECT TO THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, ANY RESIDENT OF THIS STATE WHO POSSESSES A VALID CLASS E DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A CLASS E LEARNER'S PERMIT IS ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN A COURSE.

(2) A NONRESIDENT MAY APPLY FOR AND BE ACCEPTED FOR ENROLLMENT IN A COURSE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; HOWEVER, THE REIMBURSEMENT PROVIDED UNDER § 16-605(E) MAY NOT BE MADE FOR A NONRESIDENT TRAINEE.

(3) AN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL MAY TAKE THE COURSE MORE THAN ONE TIME, BUT THE REIMBURSEMENT PROVIDED IN § 16-605(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY ONLY BE PAID ONE TIME FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL.

(4) THE ELIGIBILITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL TO ENROLL IN A COURSE SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHOUT REGARD TO WHETHER THE INDIVIDUAL IS ENROLLED IN ANY OTHER COURSE OFFERED BY THE TRAINING CENTER.

(5) FOR A COURSE THAT IS TO BE REIMBURSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A TRAINING CENTER MAY NOT CHARGE A COURSE REGISTRATION FEE IN EXCESS OF \$25.

(D) THE COURSES MAY BE OFFERED THROUGHOUT THE CALENDAR YEAR.

(E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE A PROJECT COORDINATOR TO MANAGE THE DAY-TO-DAY TASKS RELATED TO THE PROGRAM. THE PROJECT COORDINATOR SHALL BE EXPERIENCED IN THE MOTORCYCLE FIELD AND SHALL POSSESS THOSE QUALIFICATIONS AS MAY BE SPECIFIED BY THE SECRETARY.

(A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT AND ENFORCE REGULATIONS CONSISTENT WITH THIS SUBTITLE TO IMPLEMENT THE MOTORCYCLE SAFETY PROGRAM IN TRAINING CENTERS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

(B) REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:

(1) CURRICULUM, EQUIPMENT, AND FACILITY STANDARDS FOR BOTH CLASSROOM AND LABORATORY PHASES;
