RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the General Assembly requests the Maryland Congressional Delegation to introduce into Congress a resolutioncalling for the President of the United States to negotiate with the Soviet Union a permanent verifiable freeze in U.S. and U.S.S.R. testing, production, and deployment of nuclear weapons, missiles, and new aircraft that are designed primarily to deliver nuclear weapons, if—such—a—freeze—is—at—a-level—of—weaponry—that—guarantees—the national—security—of—the—United—States,—is—eonsistent—with—the fereign—and—defense—policies—of—the—federal—administration,—and is—elearly—in—the—best—interests—of—the—American—people unless such a freeze would jeopardize the national security of the United States and not be in the best interest of the American people, and to urge the President of the United States to negotiate such a freeze; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Maryland General Assembly urges the President of the United States to negotiate with the Soviet Union for a mutual verifiable freeze in testing, production, and deployment of nuclear weapons, missiles, and delivery aircraft, unless such a freeze would jeopardize the national security of the United States and not be in the best interest of the American people; and be it further
