RESOLVED, That the Governor designate the chairman of the commission; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the commission be appointed by June 17, 1983 and provide its final report and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 17, 1983; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the staff for the commission be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference; and be it further
