Article - Natural Resources Section 4-213 Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-213.

- (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ASSESS ANNUALLY ON EVERY NONRESIDENT APPLICANT FOR ANY LICENSE UNDER SUBTITLES 7, 8, AND 9 OF THIS TITLE, IN ADDITION TO THE NORMAL APPLICATION FEE IMPOSED BY STATUTE, RULE, OR REGULATION, A SURCHARGE WHICH SHALL BE THE GREATER OF:
- (1) AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TOTAL FEE CHARGED A MARYLAND RESIDENT TO ENGAGE IN LIKE FISHING ACTIVITIES IN THE STATE OF RESIDENCE OF THE NONRESIDENT APPLICANT, AND THE NORMAL LICENSE FEE FOR THE FISHING ACTIVITY IN MARYLAND; OR
  - (2) \$350.
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT IMPOSE A SURCHARGE UNDER THIS SECTION FOR THE ISSUANCE TO A NONRESIDENT OF A SPORTING LICENSE TO CATCH CRABS UNDER § 4-804(G) OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this  $\;$  Act  $\;$  shall take effect July 1, 1983.
