DETERMINE THAT THE TRANSACTION WILL NOT RESULT IN:

- (I) THE REMOVAL OF THE BUSINESS OPERATIONS OF ANY PERSON BENEFITING FROM THE TRANSACTION, FROM ONE COUNTY TO ANOTHER COUNTY: OR
- (II) THE ABANDONMENT OF THE BUSINESS OPERATIONS OF ANY PERSON BENEFITING FROM THE TRANSACTION, IN THE STATE; OR
- (2) IF THE TRANSACTION WILL RESULT IN THE OCCURRENCE OF EITHER OF THESE EVENTS, THE AUTHORITY SHALL DETERMINE THAT THE TRANSACTION WILL:
- (I) DISCOURAGE THE BUSINESS FROM LEAVING THE STATE; OR
- (II) PRESERVE THE COMPETITIVE POSITION OF THE BUSINESS IN ITS INDUSTRY.
- (D) RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT EXCLUDED. THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE AUTHORITY MAY NOT BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT UNLESS THE AUTHORITY DETERMINES, IN ITS SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION, THAT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN CONNECTION WITH A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT WILL ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (E) OPERATION BY AUTHORITY. THE AUTHORITY SHALL DETERMINE THAT THE AUTHORITY WILL NOT BE REQUIRED, EXCEPT ON DEFAULT, TO OPERATE, SERVICE, OR MAINTAIN ANY BUSINESS.
- (F) SECURITY. THE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OBLIGATIONS WITH RESPECT TO WHICH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IS PROVIDED BY THE AUTHORITY SHALL BE SECURED IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE AUTHORITY.
- (G) AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE AUTHORITY FROM THE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE INSURANCE FUND WITH RESPECT TO ANY ONE TRANSACTION MAY NOT EXCEED THE TOTAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000.
- (H) LEVERAGE OF FUND. ~ THE TOTAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF INSURANCE FROM THE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE INSURANCE FUND MAY NOT EXCEED AT ANY TIME AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 5 TIMES THE BALANCE IN THE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE INSURANCE FUND.
- (I) INSURANCE OF AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OBLIGATIONS. THE TOTAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF INSURANCE FROM THE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE INSURANCE FUND OF ANY ONE AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OBLIGATION MAY NOT EXCEED 80 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL OF THE PRINCIPAL OF, REDEMPTION OR PREPAYMENT PREMIUMS OR PENALTIES ON, AND INTEREST ON SUCH AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OBLIGATION.
