(E) THE BOARD IS A DEPOSITORY FOR AND THE ARBITRATOR OF THE SPECIALTY QUALIFICATION STANDARDS OF THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION IN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
