

State Board of Examiners for Audiologists

FOR the purpose of continuing the existence of the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists in accordance with the Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health Occupations
Section 2-502
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1981 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

2-502.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [1984] 1994.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 121.

This bill continues the existence of the State Board of Electrologists in accordance with the Regulatory Program Evaluation Act of 1978 beyond July 1, 1984 to July 1, 1994.

Senate Bill 80, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 10, 1983, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 121.
