SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes

326.

The tax hereby levied does not apply to the following sales:

(D-1) SALES OF DIESEL FUEL ~~IN-THIS-STATE~~ THAT IS TO BE USED IN THE RECLAMATION OF LAND WHICH HAS BEEN MINED FOR COAL BY MEANS OF STRIP MINING OR OPEN-PIT MINING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 239.
