In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1428.

This bill extends from June 30, 1983 to June 30, 1984 the period during which the Harford County Board of Education must include specified itemized educational revenues and expenditures in the preparation of its annual budget.

Senate Bill 762, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 31, 1983, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1428.
