AN ACT concerning

Criminal Injuries Compensation Act - Altering Number  
of Members on Criminal Injuries Compensation Board

FOR the purpose of altering the number of members on the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board; and making this Act an emergency measure.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 26A - Criminal Injuries Compensation Act
